## POSITIVE CASE OF COVID -19 ON THE GARDEN RIVER FIRST NATION

On April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the Garden River First Nation was made aware that there is confirmed case of COVID-19 associated with a person who resides within the community. Algoma Public Health is working with our community health nurses to provide follow-up and support for this person.

The confirmed case is currently self-isolating and all close contacts are being notified and have been advised to self isolate.

A person who is ill deserves compassion, support and access to the health care services they require while they are isolating.
