NOTICE TO COMMUNITY FOR IMMEDIATE DISTRIBUTION

LOW RISK PUBLIC EXPOSURE NOTIFICATION

On November 16th, 2021 the Garden River First Nation was made aware of a low risk public exposure within the community.

The Garden River Wellness Center, in partnership with the Algoma Public Health Unit is advising anyone who attended the outdoor, 11:00am Remembrance Day Ceremony, located at 7 Shingwauk St., in Garden River First Nation on November 11th, 2021 of a potential low-risk exposure to COVID-19.

Actions to take:

Any individual who was present on the date and times listed in the potential exposure is asked to:

- Self-monitor** for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 for 10 days from potential exposure.
- Self-isolate** immediately if symptoms develop.
- Seek testing** if symptoms occur.
