

October 7th, 2020 For Immediate Release COVID-19 COMMUNITY NOTICE

With the number of COVID-19 cases rising in the Province of Ontario, we are strongly urging community members to:

- Avoid non-essential travel outside of the Algoma District;
- Avoid close contact with persons outside of your household;
 Stay home if you are sick;
- Maintain a maximum of 10 persons for private indoor gatherings; and,
 Maintain a maximum of 25 persons for private outside gatherings.

We highly recommend that any community members who has visited anywhere outside of the Algoma District to self-isolate for 14 days. This is not a mandatory order, although we encourage members to exercise safe practices when leaving the District of Algoma and returning to the Community.

We do not know the extent of the risk of a Second Wave of COVID-19 and members are encouraged to exercise precautionary measures to reduce the chances of the virus entering and spreading throughout the community.

The First Nation continues to operate with visitor restrictions in place at all departments. Wear a mask or face shield in all public indoor settings and any setting where you cannot stay at least 2 metres apart from another person who is not a member of your household. Hand sanitizer stations are available at all indoor locations within the Community.

We remain proactive in safeguarding the health, safety, welfare and well being of our employees and community members with the current safety measures in place.

For those members who self-isolate, we thank you. Stay home and refrain from visiting those persons of vulnerable status and the elderly.
