Summary of Function:

Adults in Motion Private School (AIM) offers students within Garden River First Nation the opportunity to work toward their high school diploma through Co-operative Education and Independent study. The purpose of this position is to bring land based learning into the curriculum and to provide an environmental approach to learning that recognizes the connection and relationship of Indigenous peoples to the land and to re-engage youth in their own education, build community connectedness, and revitalize our languages and practices. The successful candidate will report directly to the Adults In Motion Teacher/Coordinator.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Planning, preparing, and delivering instructional activities to either small or large groups and designing appropriate lessons/workshops/exercises to suit the size and learning needs of the group
- Meet course and school-wide student performance goals
- Establish and communicate clear objectives for all learning activities
- Manage student behaviour in the classroom
- Create positive educational climate for students to learn in
- Prepare and distribute required reports
- Observe and evaluate student's performance, provide appropriate feedback, and maintain records of pupils' progress and development
- Create a classroom environment conducive to learning by employing a variety of appropriate teaching strategies
- Assist with ongoing curriculum revision process, including the revision of written courses of study
- Assist with administrative tasks/duties
- Assisting in the promotion of adult education initiatives within the community
- Participating in and organizing extracurricular activities
- Participate in community activities and training initiatives.

Qualifications

- Hold a Certificate of Registration for Ontario College of Teachers valid for assignment as a Secondary Teacher at the time of application;
- Hold qualifications in the Intermediate and Senior divisions;
- Experience teaching Adults and/or First Nation students;
- Experience working in an Alternative School environment;
- A commitment to the improvement of student achievement;
- Demonstrated sensitivity to and knowledge to the First Nation cultural values and traditions;
- Ability to use good judgement in assessing difficult situations;
- Ability to be consistent and display a positive/helpful attitude;
- Flexibility required to keep pace with an ever-changing environment;
- Willingness to accept changes in work practices and technology;
- Ability to work under pressure to meet deadlines and ability to work independently and collaboratively as a member of a team;
- Excellent organizational and time management skills, interpersonal and communications skills;
- Excellent computer skills (including MS Word, Word Perfect, Excel, Internet, Outlook, Email);
- Ability to report for work as scheduled;
