

REPOSTING GARDEN RIVER FIRST NATION

ALCOHOL & GAMING COMMISSION

OVERVIEW:

Garden River First Nation is seeking five (5) commissioners to sit on the Alcohol & Gaming Commission to provide a lawful basis for the regulation and control of alcohol and lottery scheme activity conducted within and from the Garden River First Nation Territory. The Commission will promote and preserve economic development, charitable purposes and self-government. The Garden River First Nation Gaming Commission is overall responsible to Chief and Council.

ROLES:

- Protect the assets of Garden River First Nation and ensure the safety of the members as related to gaming;
- Protect the integrity of all lottery scheme activity and liquor related activities on Garden River First Nation territory;
- Promote sovereignty and economic self-sufficiency of the Garden River First Nation by implementing reasonable regulation that facilitates the independent operation of gaming activities on the Garden River First Nation Territory; and
- Respect and honour the laws and by-laws of Garden River First Nation.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Grant /deny applicable gaming and/or liquor licenses to members, vendors and establishments;
- Evaluate applications and issues appropriate licenses to members, vendors and establishments;
- Conduct in compliance with the Garden River First Nation Gaming Law;
- Responsible for the implementation and administration of applicable laws and by-laws;
- Finalize the gaming commission regulations; and
- Create and administer the Liquor License Act and Special Occasion Permits.

QUALIFICATIONS:


- Must be a band member of the Garden River First Nation;
- Must be at least 19 years of age;
- Must be willing to provide a CPIC;
- Elders encouraged to apply;
- Ability to communicate both written and orally is an asset;
- Some knowledge of gaming and alcohol regulations is an asset;
- Familiar with developing policy and procedures; and
- You are not eligible if you are an operator, owner or employee of any gaming related activity or organization.
