What is Post-Majority Care:

Post-Majority Care Services are supports available to qualifying Indigenous youths who were formerly in care or who are preparing to transition out of care to independent living.

What Is Available:

- Educational and Professional Development Opportunities
- Financial and housing support
- Physical, mental, and social well-being supports
- Reconnection with land, culture, language and community

Who Is Eligible:

You could be eligible if:

- You are a member of or affiliated with a North Shore First Nation
- Transitioned out of care at approximately your 18th birthday
- Have not yet reached your 26th birthday
